Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2019

Tasting Notes:	New Zealand is famous for its Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc and this wine showcases some of the vibrant fruit characters the region is known for. Underlying aromas of capsicum and tomato leaf merge with fresh passionfruit and gooseberry on the palate. Finishing with a bold zesty acidity.
Winemakers Notes:	Some of the best Sauvignon Blanc in Marlborough comes from the Southern Valleys, known for being weightier than from other areas. We had the grapes picked and lightly pressed in Marlborough. The juice was sent up to us not long after where it underwent a long and cool fermentation, retaining the vibrant aromatics we desired.
Food Match:	Perfect with calamari, although is just as amazing with a wide range of other seafood.
Cellaring:	Cellaring not needed for this, best drunk within 3 years.
