

Soljans Estate Two Daughters Rosé 2019

Tasting Notes: On the nose you get red cherry and fresh raspberries.

On the palate, you get vibrant strawberries and lime with a floral rose finishing it off. Off dry in style, being perfect for

the summer months.

Winemakers Notes: The name Two Daughters comes from Tony and Colleen

Soljan's two daughters, Tonia and Lisa. Both of whom

enjoy this wine which was made in an off dry style from a blend

of grape varieties. A long cool fermentation and short skin contact time allow the rose colour and fresh, fruitiness to

be maintained.

Food Match: A stunning match to cheese boards or antipasto platters as

it pairs well to a wide range of meats and salads.

the next few years.
